

MINUTES OF 2015 ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The meeting was held on Monday 20th July 2015 at HCA.

Committee members present:

Minutes of 2014 AGM

The minutes of the 2014 AGM were accepted as an accurate record of that meeting.

Chairman's Report

The Chairman said that the 2014-15 playing season had passed without any problems or disputes, and thanked the Committee. Following the untimely death of Treasurer John Farrington and the resignation of Chairman Mike Robinson, and EGM was held in April to discussion-going issues and elect replacements: Peter Jackling as Chairman and Norman Ball as Treasurer.

Treasurer's Report

Against an income of £722 a small deficit (£73) was reported, well within budget, leaving a carried forward surplus of £2,499. Subscriptions for 2015/16 were agreed as £15.00 per team. The accounts were accepted.

Results Secretaries' reports

The clubs winning each of the divisions and the cup were congratulated.

The format of the Medley league was discussed – it was agreed that Gareth would confirm this after discussion with the participating clubs.

At the request of All Saints a discussion was held about the possibility of running a Men's league of 4 players. No-one present expressed enthusiasm for the idea so it will be reviewed after league applications and again next year.

Election of Officers

The Committee was re-elected unopposed.

- Fixtures meeting is to be held at HCA at 7:30 on Monday 7th September
- **Refreshments** at matches no guidelines were agreed but clubs should advise the away team if they do not provide any.

 - Shuttles new cheaper plastic shuttles available to trial
 - Involving more people in club badminton, including 'No strings' sessions, Essentials courses, and 'Smash up!' in schools
- Peter Jackling asked that all clubs ensure their *contact details* are provided and up-to-date to ensure accurate production of the handbook, and commented that email addresses are not given out.
